





### Every song sounds different.





However, when the fateful day of Sept. 20, 2019, came around, only about 150 people showed up, and all that happened was some standing around and talking with the guards.


No secrets were uncovered and no aliens were rescued—that is, until a few months

> This quote has sparked talk of a rumored second raid on June 13, 2020, as a quest to discover more secrets and find out what happened to Louis Booker—the man who made it into Area 51.
