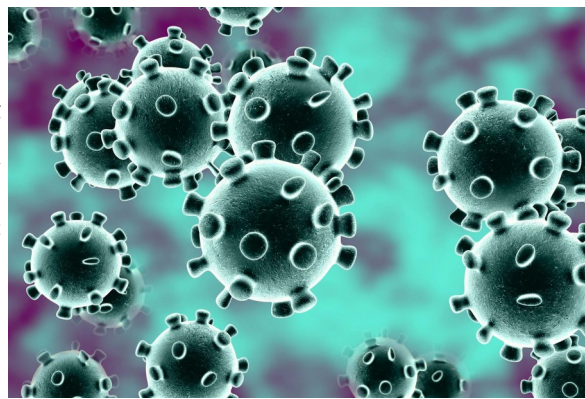

# New World Records

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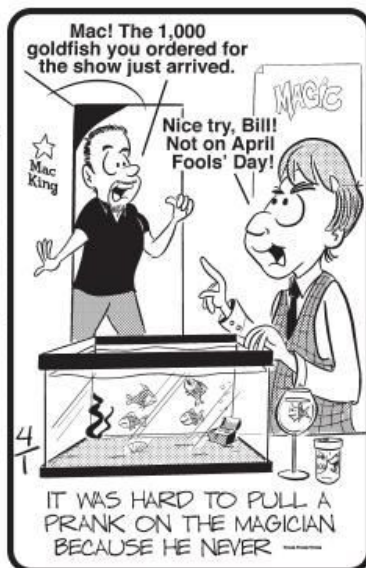
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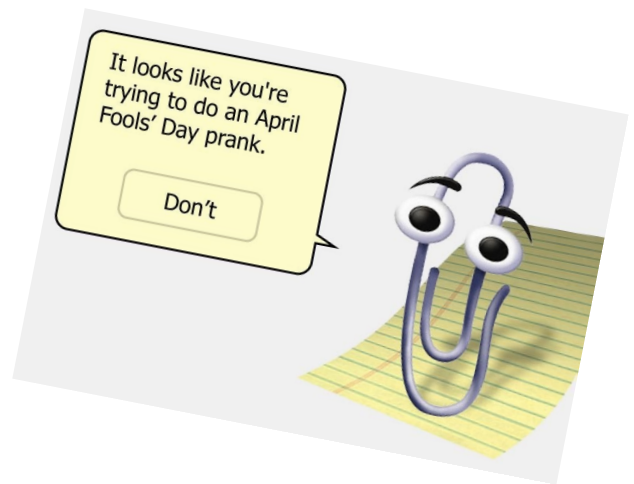

# The Man Who Made It into Area 51
